<b>Science</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To name the main parts of a flowering plant</li> <li>To observe closely the main structures of a flowering plant</li> <li>To identify and name a variety of wild and garden plants</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To identify and describe the basic structure of trees.</li> <li>To identify the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees</li> </ul>
<b>Computing</b>	<p>In Computing we will be learning about data. We will learn how to collect data before labelling it and sorting into groups that share similarities or attributes. We will be learning a variety of ways to present the data we have collected, using it to make comparisons and answer questions.</p>
<b>Geography</b>	<p>This half term we will be discovering more about continents and oceans. We will be using maps to help us locate and name them. We will be learning about the human and physical features found around the continent we live in, Europe; as well comparing geographical features of the UK and China.</p>
<b>PSHE</b>	<p>Our topic this half term is Healthy Me. This includes Jigsaw learning on how to make healthy choices and how making these positive lifestyle choices can make us feel great. We will learn why keeping ourselves clean is important to our health. We will learn strategies to stay safe when we are crossing the road and understand the role medicine has in keeping us healthy.</p>
<b>Happy Mind</b>	<p>In Happy Mind, we will be learning how to relate positively with others. We will learn how active listening and being able to stop, understand and listen are key skills for friendship building. As always practising Happy Breathing will help us along the way!</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p>In our first PE session of the week, we will be exploring Gymnastics. We will be learning how to jump, roll, balance and travel before making sequences of all our new moves. Later in the week with Coach, we will be practising our Net and Wall Game skills, throwing, catching, tracking and hitting a ball.</p>

<b>Music</b>	<p>This half term, we will be shifting our focus to Reggae music. Using the Charanga music scheme we will be finding the pulse, rhythm and pitch of their Zootime song as well as listening and appraising reggae classics by Jimmy Cliff, ASWAD, UB40 and Marcia Griffiths.</p>
<b>DT</b>	<p>Our focus in Design and Technology is creating movement with mechanisms. We will be discovering how we can use levers, sliders, pivots and wheels to make images move across a background. We will then design, make and evaluate our own Minibeast themed moving mechanisms.</p>
<b>R.E.</b>	<p>In RE this half term, we will be learning what Jesus taught Christians. We will be exploring the parables of 'The Lost Sheep' and 'The Good Samaritan'. We will learn what Jesus wanted to tell his followers at the Sermon on the Mount. We will also be looking at how Christians believe that Jesus' actions help them know how to live a good life.</p>
<b>Outdoor Learning</b>	<p>This half term we will endeavour to take our learning outside as much as possible. We aim to learn outside of the classroom at least once a week. Whether it is Maths, PSHE, Science or Storytime, learning is so much fun in the fresh air!</p>
