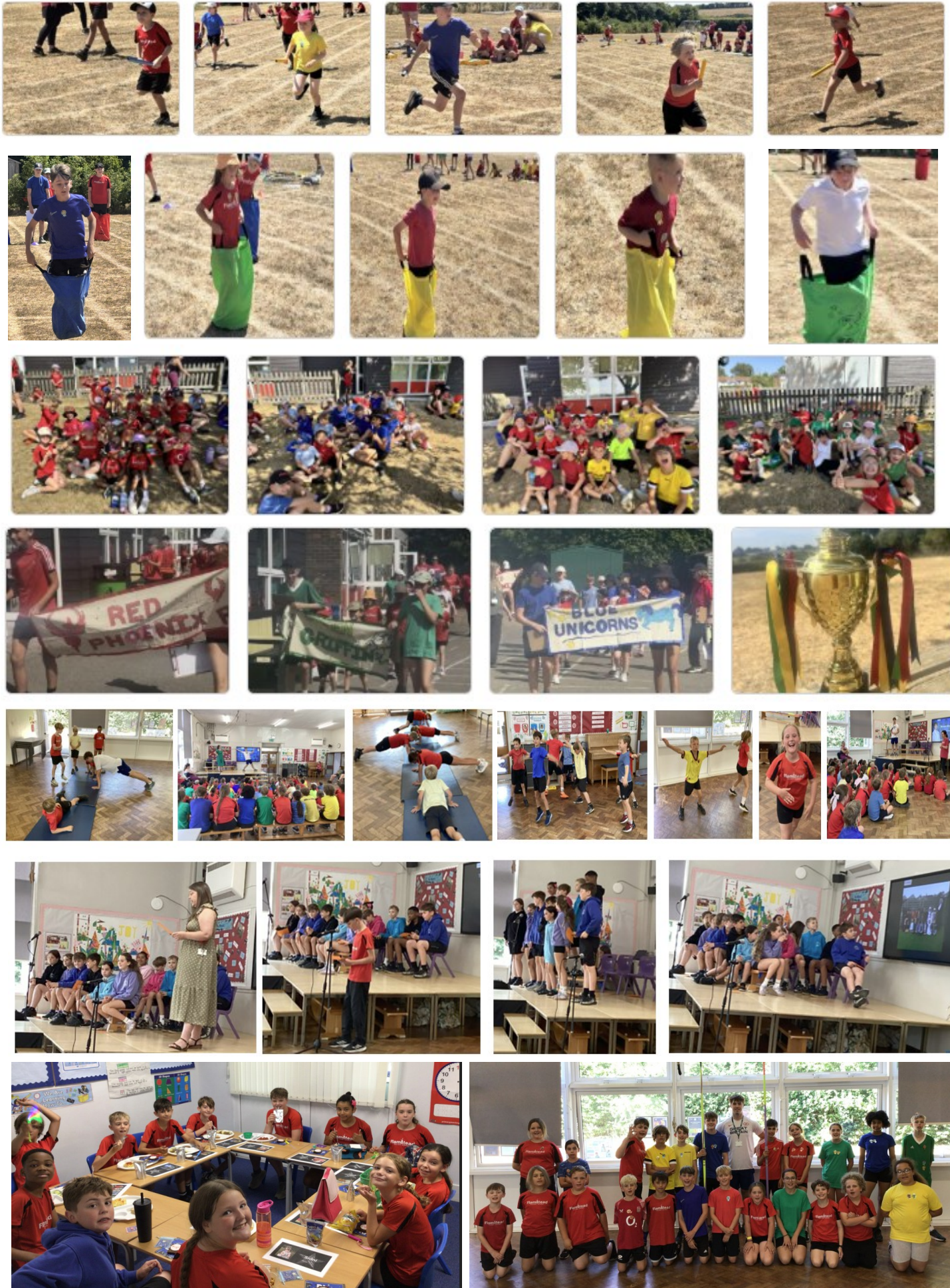
We look forward to seeing you all again on Thursday 3rd September.
